The decision of the judges shall be final and binding.



All participants are supposed to be in school uniform.




They must wear their identity cards through out the day.

Quiz questions will be based on subjects related to commerce, accountancy, economics, business world, mental ability etc.




The stage round shall include an audio-visual series of questions.
