 Refreshments and lunch will be provided by the organising school.
 There will be a help desk for queries and doubts during the fest.
 The teams are expected to report by 8:00 am.

- Students are requested to be in school uniform at all times during the competitions.
- The participants must wear their identity card provided by the Fest organisers throughout the day.

The decision of the judges shall be final and binding.

- It is the resposibility of the teachers escort to see that the students maintain discipline and decorum throughout. A team can be disqualified, if it fails to maintain discipline.
- St. Peter's College being the organising school will not be participating in the Fest.
- Out-station schools are requested to send their confirmation by 25th September so that necessary arrangements for accommodation.

Teams will be required to come up with innovative ideas for the enactment. Each team will get 2 minutes to perform on stage.

Participants are required to bring their own materials like papers, colours, props and dress.

Different forms of expressions like short skit, jingles, slogans or any innovative forms can be incorporated.

Background music will be an add on for the enactment. Language can be either Hindi or English.

You may choose any one of the following topics/products.

Standard post processing is allowed (10% cropping,touch up of brightness,saturation & contrast)

Only pictures clicked with DSLR will be considered. The participant will have to submit 3 best pictures.

The B-World has the right to use the pictures captured by the participants on social media with the 'B-World 2015' insignia on them.

THEME: St. Peter's College through lens.

NOTE: There will also be a separate GALLERY Exhibition on theme 'HOPE'. Any number of students from the schools can send their CDs latest by 1st October,2015 for the display. You have to deposit the photographs in A3 size along with the CD which contains the RAW format, via post or personally. There will be separate awards of merit for the Gallery Exhibition.

The first speaker from a team has to introduce the topic and express his/her views for 2 minutes. The second speaker will also be given 2 minutes to further develop the axis on the topic and conclude the speech.

The topics will be allotted to the participants on the basis of CHIT PICK. There will be a separate topic for each team.
